

As we continue to seek God's guidance and will for use of our Parsonage home (formerly Welcome House Hillsborough), we ask for your prayers and input as to how it can be used to serve our community and be the hands and feet of Jesus. Please share your thoughts and ideas with your deacons.





On September 28, Young Life and Wyld Life leaders serving students of Orange High School, Cedar Ridge High School, Orange Middle School and Eno River Academy worshipped at FBCH and spoke to the church of their appreciation and thanksgiving for its partnership in hosting their ministry in Hillsborough. That ministry occurs when these leaders come to Hillsborough and FBCH multiple times a week to lead Bible studies, attend kids' extracurricular activities, host hang outs in local gathering spots like Whit's, and have "club" – an ice-breaking hour of games, skits, and music for students with a clear, concise Gospel message as their evening together with leaders concludes.

The leaders explained that what makes Young Life unique in its approach to youth evangelism is the desire to enter the world of kids on their turf and in their culture to build genuine friendships that reflect the relevance and excitement of a relationship with Christ. Young Life is not a place but a set of adult and student relationships that grow and mature in Good News wherever kids get together with their leaders. That's why FBCH's support has such an impact for Hillsborough youth this year. For a mobile ministry and its required logistics for middle school students and their parents, a consistent location associated with a church, especially for Wyld Life events, enables the leader teams to be more effective, credible and accountable in forging their relationships with students and local families. The opportunities provided through FBCH for students' consistent interaction with the Gospel each week have enabled kids to explore big questions about faith, and several students have committed themselves to Christ this fall. THANK YOU, FBCH, for all the ways you provide for these ministry activities to welcome kids into the Kingdom of God in Hillsborough.

As you give thanks this holiday season, will you also lift to the Lord a prayer request for Young Life ministries in Hillsborough? The leader teams at Cedar Ridge and Eno River Academy have asked for prayers that supporters will emerge at these two schools who can assist leaders with increased access to campus life to grow participation from these student communities in local Wyld Life events.
