In today's world the gift of PRESENCE is hard to come by. Life is digitally driven and increasingly impersonal as we rely more and more on technology for everyday transactions and essential tasks. Time being present with one another is undervalued in our current culture.

When the holidays come, it is closeness and connection that we seek to make them meaningful. But we are out of practice and, for some who struggle with relationships, the face time can be insincere at best. But Christmas reminds us that God chose to come to us face to face in Jesus, with compassion and sacrifice for those He loves. He came to bestow eternal access to His power and presence in our lives.

It is this incarnational ministry that leaders of Young Life Ministries seek to emulate by regularly connecting with middle school and high school students week in and week out in Hillsborough. They are a presence that cares and are accessible, who knows kids by name and entreats them to spend time together in a transformational relationship with Jesus and His followers.

Here are a few ways that you can also be present with leaders and kids in this ministry at FBCH:

- Pray that kids will respond with openness and curiosity for the Gospel and invite friends to spend time with the leaders. 




Upcoming Opportunities
